Passionate about bringing music lovers together, they are also advocates for music accessibility and are involve d in numerous programs that provide opportunities for education in Hamilton including AIFEC, Girls Rock Ca mp, and City Kidz. Now with the release of their latest single "*Rhinestoned*", The Redhill Valleys show no sign s of slowing down as they continue to develop their sound and grow their audience.
